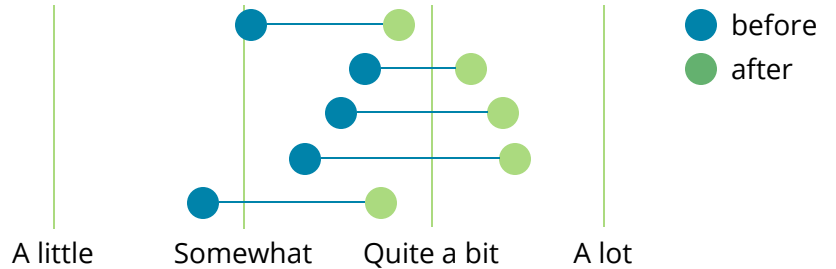

SUMMER INSTITUTE

From counselors to math teachers to instructional coaches, the Refugee Educator Foundations of Practice Course is designed for any educator who works with students of refugee and immigrant backgrounds.

- Virtual, cohort-based, facilitated by Refugee Educator Academy expert educators
- Largely self-paced with weekly cohort meetings
- Flexibility to choose between 2 parts and 2 cohorts
- Clock hours/CEUs available, including through the UCSD Extension Program
