# **Professional Learning Workshops**

Workshops are not one-size-fits-all. We build each workshop to reflect your school, district, or organization's demographics, initiatives, and specific learning goals. Examples of workshop topics include:

# Responsive, innovative, holistic teaching strategies for refugee and (im)migrant learners

### **Online Courses**

The Center for Professional Learning offers facilitated, online modules for refugee and (im)migrant educators. Each module takes between five and seven hours to complete.

Modules can be combined into a full course or taken separately. Participants who complete modules may be able to earn clock hours/CEUs (please confirm with your HR department).

# **Professional Learning Workshops**

Any of our module themes can be adapted and contextualized to support the goals of your school, district, or organization through in-person or virtual professional learning workshops.

Our professional learning workshops are designed to be **interactive and immediately relevant** to participants.

We respect and build on participants' expertise and experiences, creating opportunities for **participants to learn with and from each other** throughout each session.

CPL team members can facilitate these sessions, or co-create and support in-house facilitators in leading the sessions.

Session times depend on your goals and structures for professional learning.
